The Village Administrator reported on the following: 1) Hydrant flushing has begun this past week. 2) The two fire hydrants will be replaced this week. 3) The two vehicles and street sweeper have been sold through govdeals.com. The 1988 Dodge dump truck with snow plow-\$5,925.00; 1992 Ford F-150 pickup truck-\$1,000.00; street sweeper-\$725.00.

Solicitor, Scott Basinger, updated the Council on the status of the Peth property. Today (October 25th) Robert Kirk, who is a contractor hired by the Bank of America to conduct an inspection for the necessary repairs of the property, met with Police Chief, Scott Stant, and Village Solicitor, Scott Basinger. The Bank of America now has the authority as the mortgage holder to either have renovations done to sell or demolish said property. After discussing this matter with Mr. Basinger and Police Chief Stant, Mr. Kirk will submit a recommendation to the Bank of America this property be demolished as the renovation costs are too extensive. The Bank of America will thus make a final decision as to whether this residence be demolished or sold "as is".
