The Tax Incentive Review Council met on March 17, 2014 as to the CRA agreements with Pandora Grain. Discussion was had as to the shelter house rental fee for Brien Bowers' benefit for the Root family on May  $31^{\rm st}$ . Since this is a benefit event, it was the consensus of the Council to reduce the fee to \$1.00 for the rental of the closed shelter.

The Village Administrator presented the following: 1) The Village of Ottawa has approximately 500 new Elster water meters which they do not need. The charge for these meters would be \$143.50 per meter. The approximate cost of the new Sensus meters would be \$234.00. Mayor Schlumbohm stated for Mr. Schneck to present to Council at the next meeting the comparable costs between the Elster and Sensus meters, including readers and billing software. 2) It was the consensus of the Council for the Village to purchase the flowers for Main Street for this season.

Discussion was had as to the waterline improvements discussed at the previous meeting. After some discussion, it was the consensus of the Council to contact Bockrath & Associates to present a proposal as to the cost for these waterline improvements.
