The Village Administrator reported on the following: 1) One valve is yet to be installed at the lagoons. Mr. Schneck has been in contact with Dick Wahl in regards to the need for bacteria in the lagoon system. Mr. Wahl will be present at an upcoming Council Meeting to discuss cost estimates for the treatment of bacteria. 2) The Riley Township Trustees have stated they will be able to get street salt for this winter's season. Thus the Village will be sharing the cost for said salt.

Several Village residents were present to express their concerns regarding the potential cost of the Community Center's proposed restroom project. As discussed previously, no Village funds are being used in contracting with Technicon Design Group for architectural and engineering plans for said project.
