The Pandora Village Council met in Regular Session on Tuesday, February 9, 2021 at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building, with Mayor Jeremy Liechty, presiding.

Members Present: Burkholder, Gray, Eisenbach, Fricke, Braidic. Tadena Members Absent: None

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Mr. Tadena, seconded by Mr. Gray, to approve the January 26, 2021 minutes. Voting: All Yea.

Mr. Greg Bockrath, Bockrath & Associates Engineering and Surveying LLC, was present to discuss with Council the upcoming Water Tower Replacement Project. Mr. Bockrath reviewed funding information from the CDBG Residential Public Infrastructure Program and OPWC Small Government Program. Best case scenario would provide to the village \$1,250,000 in grant money and \$250,000 in loan money. Both grants can also be used to pay for engineering costs. Applications and funding would be secured in 2021 for construction in 2022. Final Design and Water Plan Approval is a requirement which has to be approved by the EPA for eligibility for the CDBG-RPIP grant and to increase scoring points for the OPWC Small Government grant.

Mr. Greg Bockrath presented two agreements to Council regarding the next phase in the Water Tower Replacement Project. The first was the Agreement for Water System Modeling in the amount of \$48,500 and the second was the Agreement for the Proposed Elevated Water Tank Detailed Design and Ohio EPA Permitting in the amount of \$46,850. Motion was made by Mr. Tadena, seconded by Mr. Fricke, to authorize Mayor Liechty to enter into both said agreements with Bockrath & Associates Engineering and Surveying, LLC. Voting: All Yea.

Motion was made by Mr. Burkholder, seconded by Mr. Eisenbach, to approve the bills as presented: Total non-payroll of \$19,219.01 and payroll of \$9,068.53, for a total of \$28,287.54. Voting: All Yea.
